
The following Anti Ragging Committee is hereby constituted at the Institute level.

Important Notice

The Anti Ragging Squad

The students of MEC, Basna are hereby warned that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING". If they are found guilty of ragging, they are liable for punishment without prejudice to any other criminal action that may be taken under any penal law. As per the Gazette of India July 4, 2009 UGC defines. What constitutes Ragging:-Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student

With or without and intent to drive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student or any fresher or any other student, Administrative action in the event of ragging:- Depending on the nature and gravity of the guilty established by the Anti Ragging Squad, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:

- Cancellation of admission
- Suspension from attending classes
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.

- Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the offence of ragging at the institution shall resort to collective punishment

Sr. No. : The Anti Ragging Squad is constituted with the following members for maintaining discipline in the campus. The Squad in full or parts may be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels and other hot spots and will be empowered to inspect places of potential ragging. The Squad will work under the overall guidance of anti-ragging committee. The organization of the Squad is as under:
